Family Fun Break

Make Your Own Sock Puppet!



SUGGESTED SUPPLIES:

1 clean sock
2 buttons
6 yards of yarn
needle (and/or glue)
felt or cloth



PUT YOUR HAND INSIDE THE SOCK WITH YOUR FINGERS AT THE TOES OF THE SOCK AND YOUR THUMB AT THE HEEL.

CURL YOUR FINGERS IN TO MEET YOUR THUMB. MARK THE PLACEMENT OF THE EYES ON TOP OF YOUR KNUCKLES.





THREAD YOUR NEEDLE WITH SOME YARN.

USE THE NEEDLE TO PULL THE YARN

THROUGH TO THE INSIDE OF THE SOCK.

TURN YOUR SOCK INSIDE OUT AND TIE THE

BUTTON ONTO THE SOCK. CUT OFF EXTRA

YARN. REPEAT FOR SECOND EYE.





USE THE YARN TO MAKE HAIR - LONG, SHORT, OR BRAIDED... CUT OFF A SHORT PIECE OF YARN TO TIE THE MIDDLE.

ATTACH THE HAIR TO YOUR PUPPET BY SEWING AROUND THE KNOTTED SECTION THROUGH THE SOCK.





USING FELT OR CLOTH AND THE PATTERNS,
CUT OUT THE SHAPES AND USE THESE TO
MAKE YOUR PUPPET UNIQUE.
YOU CAN USE THESE PIECES TO MAKE A
MUSTACHE, A BOW, A NOSE...OR CREATE
YOUR OWN ACCESSORIES FOR YOUR
PUPPET.
